



- Free redistribution
- Include source code
- Modifications and derived works
- Integrity of author's source code
- No discrimination against person and groups
- No discrimination against fields of endeavor
- Distribution of license
- License not specific to a product
- License not restricting other software
- License technology neutral

OSS Freedoms Freedom 0 to run the program, for any purpose Freedom 1 to study how the program works, and change it to make it do what you wish Freedom 2 to redistribute copies Freedom 3 to distribute copies of your modified versions to others


Industry collaboration requires



The main goal of the consortium is to support the Capella solution, in association with the field-proven Arcadia methodology, to become the leading Model-Based Systems Engineering (MBSE) solution. Targeted for industrial users, Capella provides a mature, full-featured, sustainable solution which can be widely distributed as an open source alternative to existing proprietary modeling tools.


